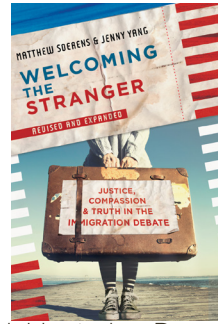

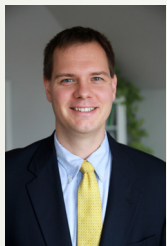
Welcome to Community Fellowship!
