






Connecting Hearts Christmas Dinner

Santiago, Dominican Republic - "Here we come!"

A team of 10 from CF will travel to the DR from November 28 – December 4 to serve with the Mike Silva International (MSI) evangelistic festival. You can partner with this team to provide <u>compassion and hope</u> to people in the DR.
