

# Current Volunteer Opportunities



**In partnership** with World Relief, the people of Community Fellowship will make a difference in the lives of vulnerable and marginalized in our community through these opportunities.

## **Good Neighbor Team (GNT):**

Each GNT is comprised of 4-6 committed people from a local church who serve together to welcome, help acclimate and relationally engage a refugee family during the first six months after their arrival in America. Refugee families are arriving from many different countries including Afghanistan, Sudan and Myanmar. CF hopes to form two or more Good Neighbor Teams in 2022.

**Citizenship Clinic:** CF will host a World Relief sponsored Citizenship Clinic on Saturday, March 12. Volunteers will be needed for this Citizenship Clinic to welcome and assist refugees and immigrants with their citizenship process during this one-day event. Morning and afternoon shifts are available.

## **Refugee Middle School Student Program:**

CF will host a World Relief sponsored after school activity time for refugee middle school students on Thursday afternoons from 3:00 – 5:00 p.m. beginning on March 10 through the end of May. Activities will include snacks, recreation, crafts, games and basic tutoring assistance with homework. CF is looking for 4-6 committed volunteers to serve alongside World Relief staff to help facilitate this weekly after school program.
