In-Home Discipleship Guide

Below is a guide to help prepare you (and your small group or family) for the sermon to be delivered via livestream on Sunday. THEME: What it means to be children of God

MEMORY VERSE: 1 John 1:7

If we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

BIG IDEA: True children of God are compelled to practice righteousness, rather than make a practice of sinning.

TEACHING PASSAGE: 1 John 3:4-10

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What does it mean to "practice" something? What would be evidences that we are practicing sin in our lives? (v4)
- 2. Why is Christs' destruction of the devils work of any benefit to us? What impact does it have on the way we live our lives each day?(v5;8)
- 3. How does abiding Christ prevent and protect us from sin? How does it enable us to practice righteousness? (vv6-7)
- 4. Read Romans 8:1-18. How do these verses provide insight to 1 John 3:9?
- 5. How are practicing righteousness and loving our brothers and sisters in Christ connected? (v10)

Teaching Passage: 1 John 3:4-10

⁴Everyone who makes a practice of sinning also practices lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. ⁵You know that he appeared in order to take away sins, and in him there is no sin. ⁶No one who abides in him keeps on sinning; no one who keeps on sinning has either seen him or known him. ⁷Little children, let no one deceive you. Whoever practices righteousness is righteous, as he is righteous. ⁸Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil. ⁹No one born of God makes a practice of sinning, for God's seed abides in him; and he cannot keep on sinning, because he has been born of God. ¹⁰By this it is evident who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil: whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not love his brother.

Activity: Make a Child of God crown

Make an obstacle course, add a sign "path of righteousness" and practice leading each other through the course. The leader should offer help to the followers when crossing the difficult parts of the course.

Level up: If you made crowns, try to keep the crown on during the whole course. It might be difficult. You will need to keep checking your crown, is it starting to fall off? Oh no, you better readjust your crown. Don't lose your crown. If you lose your crown you must start over.

Level up: Blindfold the followers. The leader can lead only by their words.

Say: What was difficult about leading/following others through this course? With the crown? With the blindfold?

Say: Abiding in Christ is like the path of righteousness obstacle course. When we were wearing the crown, we had to keep checking to make sure it was on securely. That is like abiding in Christ. We need to think about our faith to live like a child of God to stay on the path of righteousness.

Say: When we were blindfolded it was sometimes scary. We were not able to see what was ahead of us. We had to trust our leader. That is much like abiding in Christ. We must trust him. We must trust him when it is scary. He will never lead us off the path of righteousness.

Additional Questions:

- 1. In verse 4 John mentions lawlessness, do you think he is referring to the 10 commandments? Why or Why not?
- 2. John was writing against false teachers who claimed they knew Jesus. How does he let the believers know how to tell who true followers of Christ are? (v6;9)
- 3. What do you think John is writing about in verse 9 when he refers to "God's seed"? (1Peter 1:23-25)
